*Bringing Darkness into Light:
Sharing Stories of Redemption from Men
on Arkansas' Death Row*

**September 1, 2021
6:30 PM**



The Prison Story Project, a ministry of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Fayetteville, Arkansas, provided creative writing classes from May through October 2016 to men on Varner Prison's death row in Gould, Arkansas.

Their writing was curated into a staged reading, *On the Row*, performed by actors and toured across the country. The staged reading was filmed before a live audience while on a live tour in 2019.

St. James will host this 1 hour and 10 minute film, followed by a live Q&A period with an inmate on Arkansas' death row. This presentation, shown via a Zoom webinar platform, will also be offered to the diocese and is facilitated by Kathy McGregor, Project Director for [The Prison Story Project](#).

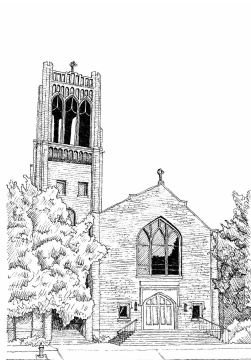
