While I was working in my office this week, listening to music (as I usually do), Mississippi Fred McDowell came on, playing *You Gotta Move*. It's one of my favorite Delta Blues songs. In it, Mississippi Fred sings:

"You may be high. You may be low. You may be rich, child. You may be po'. But when the Lord gets ready, you got to move." There is a very deep truth in the lyrics of the song. When the Lord gets ready, you've *got to* move, or you had better get out of the way.


