We Are Accepted!

St. James is EXCITED to announce that our application to host a Prime Time Family Reading program in the Fall has been approved by Louisiana Endowment for the Humanities. At the end of our tutoring program after 20 years, Melanie Torbett wisely said that perhaps

something else will come up; a new direction that we were meant to follow. Not long after Will Harp sent me the information he had received concerning this grant. Following discussions with Fr. John and members of the tutoring program, I decided to apply.

Melanie assisted with the application. Tish Fresh, Paige Quillin, and Brannon & Amy Andrus agreed to be major players on the team. Our application was approved based on several considerations, including our listed priorities and the ability of our site to recruit and retain <u>underserved families with demonstrated need.</u> This unique outcomes-based family literacy program will be offered to 15 families on 6 Thursday evenings from October 13 - November 17. The entire family is invited to dinner followed by a reading program based on a children's book which the family keeps. Activities are available for all ages attending.

As an approved program we will receive:

- Program support stipend (\$1,000 we will use for dinners)
- Team member stipends
- Program books for up to 15 families to keep
- Promotional materials digital kit (flyers, posters, & other items to recruit families)
- Training for new team members

You, too, will have the opportunity to be a part! The church community will be asked to donate some time in the kitchen and as greeters, making the families feel welcomed. So stay tuned to more details in the near future! ~ Rita Klock


