#### From Fr. John

In last Sunday's sermon, I asked the question, "What are you being called to do?" As I said in that sermon, I believe that God is calling all of us to something, all the time. God created us all to worship. A part of our worship is to discern what it is that God wants from each of us and then to try as best we can to do that thing.

The pandemic caused almost all the ministries of St. James to cease operation. Now I am asked, "Is X ministry going to restart?" My answer is always the same. If people want the ministry to restart, or continue, then people will step up and be involved in the next evolution of it. But if people are not interested enough to get involved in restarting or continuing a ministry, that is a good indicator that the season for that ministry is over, at least for now.

Here are a couple of examples of ministries that may not continue without people volunteering and someone taking over their operation:

- · Coffee hour following the 10:30 service, and
- Sunday morning Christian Formation (what was previously called "Sunday School") for all ages

Both ministries need people, to give them a chance to thrive.

If there are ministries at St. James that you have really missed since COVID hit, call/come by/email/text me. Let's have a conversation about what it would look like if a particular ministry restarted. If you have an idea for a something new, I make the same request of you.

The bottom line here is: St. James is looking to move forward. But it cannot do so without the help of the congregation. The vestry, church staff, and I do everything we can, but we need you. Let's work together to keep moving forward. And in the process, we will hopefully find what it is that God is calling you to, right now.


# Good Food Project Workday Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup> 7:30am – 9:30am


