## From Fr. John

Here we are, another school year has started – and another program year for the church is about to begin. Over recent weeks, I have been looking for people who are interested and willing to work with children on Sunday mornings, between services. We are also looking for adults to run a program for children who are not old enough for EYC on Wednesday nights. The church staff would support those who might be interested in being a part of children's Christian development. But the need is indeed great.

Speaking of our program year, on September 7<sup>th</sup> we will begin Wednesday evening gatherings. Dinner is at 6:00pm. The first week we will have the main dish catered. If you would be willing to help with salad or dessert, please let Drew Texada know (<u>atexada@ssplaw.com</u>) or me know. After dinner we will gather in the Parlor where we will have our program.

For the Fall, our Wednesday program will be *Faith in Film.* It is based, in part, on a book entitled The Gospel According to Hollywood, by Greg Garrett. Over the course of this class, we will look at ways in which we can see God in films. Although some of the clips we will view come from religious-themed movies, like *The Ten Commandments*, we will primarily be looking for images of faith and of God in what are normally considered "secular" films, such as *Cool Hand Luke*. I look forward to bringing this material to you. I hope that you will enjoy it as well.

On Sunday mornings, beginning on September 11<sup>th</sup>, at 9:15am, we restart our adult Christian Formation classes. We will start with a study of the Gospel of Matthew, using a video that is the word-for-word Gospel, but with actors bringing the action to life. There will be discussion of what we see and hear each week. There is no preparation needed for each class. Just show up and join in.


## **Outreach for September**


