It is at the Annual Parish Meeting that the congregation sees the year's budget, as passed by the Vestry. The other important business of the meeting are the elections of new Vestry members and Delegates to Diocesan Convention.

The 2023 Vestry chose a slate of candidates for the Vestry positions to be filled. But the Delegates to Convention are still needed. We have one volunteer delegate, but we need a total of four. If you have never been to Convention, it is not really a chore. It is one Saturday (May 4th), from about 8:30 to about 3:00. It is held in Pineville, so the drive is not bad. The presentations will not bore you to death and you'll get to have good conversations with other Episcopalians. And lunch is included. All-in-all, it's not a bad day. So give it some thought, and if you are interested, let me know.

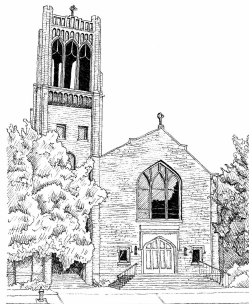
