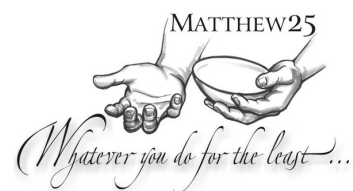
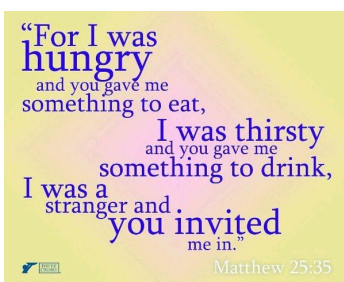
Fight Hunger. Spark Change.

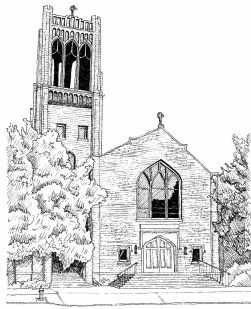
